But there are women who are at risk of pregnancy-related complications such as

pre-term labor, pre-eclampsia, twin or triplet pregnancies, and pregnant women with fetuses at risk.

Pre-conception Care Clinic

Pre-conception care includes any intervention to optimise a woman's health before pregnancy with the aim to improve maternal, newborn and child health outcomes. At Mediheal, pre-conception care bridges the gap in the continuum of care, and addresses pre-pregnancy health risks and health problems that could have negative maternal and fetal consequences.

We diagnose and counsel women about their pregnancy, calculate the risks if any and start treatment to optimise outcome of future pregnancies. We work towards reducing complications for the mother and the baby and make sure that pregnancy-related disability minimizes.

Care for Elderly Women

Elderly women need easy access to quality healthcare, essentials of care delivery, and above all compassion. At Mediheal, we understand the requirement of attaining the goal of appropriate medical care for older women and that it requires knowledge of the changes due to aging, skills in recognition and treatment of disease, and an effort to provide help and avoid harm. We ensure that the essential capabilities are in place to take care of the elderly woman.

Additional Reasons to See a Maternal-Fetal Medicine (MFM) Specialist

The most common reason for a woman seeing MFM sub-specialist is that she is considered at risk for complications during pregnancy.

There are several reasons why a woman may experience complications during pregnancy, these reasons may classify her as high-risk and can be caused by medical and surgical disorders during pregnancy.

These disorders include, but are not limited to:

- Heart disease
- High blood pressure
- Pre-eclamsia (toxemia)
- Diabetes
- Thyroid disorders
- · Kidney disease
- Gastrointestinal disease
- Infectious diseases
- Cancer (patients receiving chemotherapy)

Healthy women may also need to see a MFM sub-specialist. The following are reasons a healthy woman without medical or surgical disorders may need to see a MFM sub-specialist. All of these reasons create the potential for

pre-term birth and complications:

- Pregnant with multiple babies (twins, triplets, or more)
- Recurrent pregnancy loss
- Suspected fetal growth restriction (baby not growing properly)
- Evidence of possible birth defects

Specialists at Mediheal Group of Hospital recognise and manage both normal and highrisk births, and carry out high-risk obstetric operations. The Department of Fetomaternal Medicine at Mediheal also involves giving psychological care to women in labour and knowing how to relieve pain during birth.
